Desktops start at \$50 and laptops start at \$100. Includes a one-year warranty on hardware. Additional features available for purchase: Microsoft Office and Wi-Fi adapter for wireless Internet service.

In order to purchase a computer through Connecting For Good, the following income guidelines must be met. Please bring one (1) piece of documentation from each category:.

<b>Proof of:</b>	<b>Documents:</b>
Identity	State ID card, Driver's License, US Military ID, or Alien Registration/Permanent Resident Card
Income Assistance Information	Social Security award letter, Medicaid card, EBT Card, Veterans Assistance letter, Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher, Public Housing, Senior Citizens Housing, or previous year's tax form
Income Eligibility	Purchasers must earn no more than 200% of the HHS Federal Poverty Guidelines.

## Phones

### Lifeline

Lifeline is a federal program that provides a monthly benefit of \$9.25 to reduce or eliminate the cost of phone/internet connectivity for eligible households.

Eligibility Guidelines for the Lifeline Assistance Program in Missouri

You are eligible if you receive benefits from any of these programs in Missouri:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (Food Stamps or SNAP)
- Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- Veterans Pension and Survivor's Benefit.
- Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance (BIA)
- Tribally Administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (Tribal TANF)
- Tribal Head Start (only those households meeting its income qualifying standard)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)

## Low-Cost Devices in KC

Another way to qualify is through your low-income levels. If your Total Household Income is at or under 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, you may qualify that with this method. Here are the income limits, calculated for you:

INCOME BASED ELIGIBILITY FOR LIFELINE IN MISSOURI	
Members in Household	Annual income
1 member	\$16,281
2 members	\$21,924
3 members	\$27,567
4 members	\$33,210

For each additional member add \$5,643 annually.
